RECREATION COMMITTEE MEETING

Monday, July 13, 2020

The Recreation Committee for the Village of Grantsburg met on Monday, July 13, 2020, at 5:00 pm at the Village Office, 316 S. Brad Street, Grantsburg, WI.

Present: Chairman/Trustee Muehlberg, President Longhenry, Trustee Barton

Others: Police Chief Wald, Director of Public Works Chris Bartlett, Sarah Covey, Pool Manager

CALL TO ORDER Chairman Muehlberg called the Recreation Committee meeting to order at 5:00 pm. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Community Center Use Request: A request has been received from Earl Mosley to use the Community Center for pickleball. The committee discussed a fee system that would allow smaller groups to use the center. **Motion by President Longhenry, second by Trustee Barton to recommend the Village Board add a \$10 per hour fee for groups of 30 or less individuals using the Community Center for less than 100 hours in a 12-month period, with a 2 hour minimum charge and to add “over 30 individuals” to the \$7.00 per hour fee for 100 or more hours of usage. Motion carried.**

Pool Repairs/Improvements: The Grantsburg School Board notified the Village of Grantsburg that they will be able to utilize the \$25,000 collected from taxpayers of the Grantsburg School District for pool upgrades and/or repairs since the Grantsburg Municipal Swimming Pool will not be open in 2020. This amount is collected each year for pool operations. DPW Bartlett presented the committee with multiple options **Motion by President Longhenry, second by Trustee Muehlberg to recommend the Village Board authorize the following repairs/improvements totaling \$18,415.96 at the Grantsburg Municipal Swimming Pool in 2020 and also obtain pricing for replacing tile on the pool: \$950 equipment rental from Carrico; \$2,700 paint for the pool; \$250 grind uneven concrete on the pool deck; \$12,815.96 for installing a 3 bay sink in the concession area, replacing all water faucets and plumbing to include 2 sinks, 4 toilets, 2 urinals and 8 showers; \$400 hand dryer; \$1,300 to put concrete steps in the shallow end of the pool once State approval is obtained. Motion carried.**

ADJOURNMENT Motion by President Longhenry, second by Trustee Barton to adjourn the meeting at 5:50 p.m. Motion carried.
