GRANTSBURG POOL RULES

All members and guests must follow these rules and staff instructions. Any misunderstandings or objections should be brought to the attention of the Pool Manager. Head Lifeguard on duty has full authority in the manager's absence.

All pool patrons must read and follow these rules.

- <u>All patrons</u> must present a valid membership number or pay the daily admission rate upon entering the pool.
- <u>The Community Pool and Park</u> are tobacco free facilities; smoking/tobacco use is prohibited on all pool grounds including the parking lot.
- **PROPER SWIM WEAR IS REQUIRED.** Sports bras, cut-offs, gym shorts, underwear/boxers are <u>NOT</u> permitted. Aqua shirts may be worn for medical reasons upon approval by the Pool Manager.
- <u>Alcoholic beverages</u> or persons under the influence of alcohol/drugs will not be permitted in the pool complex, surrounding areas or any part of the park. Use of such will result in immediate expulsion from the pool complex and park.
- <u>The use of</u> abusive or profane language or other improper conduct on pool/park property shall be grounds for expulsion.
- **<u>Glass containers</u>** of any kind are prohibited on the pool facility.
- <u>Any children</u> that are not toilet trained is required to wear specifically designed swim diapers and appropriate swim wear. Caretakers must provide their own swim diapers.
- No dogs, cats or other pets are allowed within the pool complex unless classified as a service animal.
- **<u>Running</u>**, pushing, towel snapping, dunking, horseplay, diving in shallow water or other behavior creating danger or annoyance is strictly prohibited.
- <u>Children under the age of 8</u> must be supervised at all times by a responsible person age 14 or over.

- <u>Children under the age of 12</u> who wish to use the diving board and swim in the deep end of the pool, must pass a swim test to obtain a neon colored wrist band which will allow usage of the above.
- **Only** US Coast Guard approved personal floatation devices are permitted in the pool complex. Swimmies, masks, inner tubes, snorkels, fins are not allowed.
- **Public address** equipment may be used only to deliver messages of an emergency nature.
- <u>Patrons</u> are requested to leave valuables at home. Grantsburg Community Pool, Village of Grantsburg and all staff are not responsible for lost or stolen items.
- <u>Health</u> in the pool is very important. Swimmers with lesions, inflamed eyes or discharge from nose or ears, open blisters or cuts are not permitted in the water. Bandages are not allowed in the water.
- **<u>Injuries</u>** must be reported to the manager immediately.
- **Non-swimming** children may enter any section of the pool 5 feet deep or less when accompanied by a parent/guardian, conditions permitting. Non-swimming children are never allowed in the deep water and cannot use the diving board.
- <u>Lifeguards</u> are not responsible for supervising your children outside of the pool, including the park, parking lot, picnic area, or volleyball court or after pool hours. If you are not at the pool to pick up your children when the pool closes, you will forfeit your privileges to the pool for 7 days.
- <u>Pool Staff</u> reserves the right to make a request of a patron regarding issues not written explicitly in the rules. Please keep in mind that the staff has patron safety as the primary consideration.
- **Disobeying Pool Staff** will result in immediate ejection from the pool facility.
- <u>If the pool is closed</u> for more than 1 hour due to weather, a pool pass will be issued for another day's use within the 2018 season. (If the closing is after 5:00 p.m., the pass will be for an after 5:00 p.m. admission.)
